



TEENSTREET Prayer Week 4-10 April 2011

Our purpose is to work together with the church to motivate and equip Christian teens to have a real friendship with Jesus and to reflect Him daily in their world.

This year we will take a walk through a typical day at TeenStreet, praying for key moments during the day.

Real.

Monday

Main Meetings – pray for Josh and Debs Walker and their team as they prepare this year’s Main Hall sessions, NET group materials and Big Adventures on the theme “Real.” Pray that we will get to know the Jesus of the Bible as He really is!

Tuesday

Shhh time, NET group and Big Adventure – Pray for these special times with God and with each other as we listen to what God is saying, ask questions and share together. Pray that each person at TeenStreet will draw closer to Jesus this summer.



Wednesday

Interaction Time – Pray for our friendships with one another and for all that we will learn as we play sports, create art or take part in workshops and seminars. Pray especially for safety on and off site during the active afternoon sessions.

Thursday

Behind the scenes – Pray for all the Service Team volunteers and Staff who work so hard to make TeenStreet run smoothly. Pray that every adult onsite will reflect Jesus and find joy as they serve.



Friday

Outreach and RAG – Pray that we will reflect Jesus in Offenburg as we go into the town for outreach. Pray that we will be able to help needy teenagers and young people through our Raise and Give (RAG) fund raising programme. Talk to God about how you can get involved!

Saturday

Throne Room – Pray for the evening worship times... that we will worship God in spirit and in truth! Pray for the Outbreak band as they lead us in worship.



Sunday (this is TeenStreet Sunday – why not celebrate?)

Lasting impact – TeenStreet is not just an event... pray that the impact of TeenStreet will last all year as we grow deeper in our relationship with Jesus and reflect Him in our world.



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Making the most of TeenStreet Prayer Week:

- ◆ Take a few minutes each day to pray for TeenStreet 2011 or take a longer time once during the week.
- ◆ If possible, find one or two friends or family members to pray with (you'll find it is a lot easier). You could ask some friends around for a meal or even just a coffee and take some time to pray together.
- ◆ Ask if you can pray for TeenStreet during church services or youth group meetings this week or organise a special TeenStreet prayer time.
- ◆ Find a comfortable place where you won't be distracted
- ◆ Keep your Bible with you – maybe God wants to speak to you as you speak to Him. Be ready to listen to Him.
- ◆ Try praying as you walk to school, college or work every day. You could choose different landmarks to remind you to pray for different things.
- ◆ Why not choose to "fast" from TV or Facebook or something else that takes a lot of your time (even just for a few minutes each day) and use that time for prayer instead.
- ◆ Write down Bible verses that come into your mind as you prayer or pray through a favourite Psalm.
- ◆ Write your prayer as a letter to God on a piece of paper or in your journal (notebook) if you have one.
- ◆ Create a prayer wall and stick up photos, drawings or words that remind you to pray.
- ◆ Make a collage picture (stick on different words, photos or pictures and draw or pain decorations) as you pray
- ◆ Draw or paint a picture or make a sculpture to express your prayer to God.
- ◆ Write the prayer requests on "post it" notes and stick them around your house or in your bedroom
- ◆ Organise a mini 'Throne Room' worship time and spend time praying during the evening
- ◆ Pray with a friend using Skype or Facebook chat
- ◆ Find simple ways to remind yourself to pray (for example: every time you brush your teeth or every time you have a cup of coffee, tea or your favourite drink)

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Ideas for TeenStreet Sunday: 10 April 2011

TeenStreet Sunday is a chance to tell your friends about TeenStreet and to invite them to get involved. It is also an opportunities for churches, youth groups and TeenStreet partners to unite in prayer for all that God will do this summer and throughout the year as a result of TeenStreet 2011.

Here are a few ideas to get you started:

- ➔ Choose your favourite TeenStreet T-shirt and wear it today. Tell anyone who asks you something God taught you at TeenStreet
- ➔ Ask you church leader to let you show the TeenStreet promo video to your church or show it in your youth group
- ➔ Ask your church or youth group to pray for TeenStreet and for anyone who is attending. Invite church members to become TeenStreet prayer partners
- ➔ Invite your friends to come as teens, coaches, M&Ms, Prayer Team or Service Team. If they register now, they can still get the free T-shirt (before April 30)
- ➔ Organise a fund-raising event to help with the costs of TeenStreet.
- ➔ Take a few minutes with God to remember something He taught you at TeenStreet in the past. Tell Him about what is going on in your life. If you are able to go to TeenStreet this year, pray for that time and ask God to speak to you. If you cannot go, pray for others you know who are going.
- ➔ Something else? What's your idea to celebrate TeenStreet Sunday?
